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Knowledge transfer and capacity building are main challenges as well as important preconditions needed to improve good land practices in industrial and developing countries. A growing E-Learning industry, rising numbers of people using smart phones and the improvement in internet accessibility therefore are creating new opportunities. Opportunities, that have been recognized by many organizations, which brought new E-Learning tools for land matters and related disciplines into focus.

The objective of the Masterclass is to present newly developed and land related e-learning tools of TUM, GLTN and GIZ. The Masterclass will draw attention to opportunities and challenges of e-learning and it will generate a common platform for expert exchange to discuss future development possibilities to implement e-learning for capacity building to improve land governance.

The Masterclass comprises two parts: a short presentation on actual e-learning tools and a related group works with discussions. The Masterclass will start with a small group work for a joint discussion on challenges and opportunities of e-learning for capacity building on good governance with focus on developing countries. Thereby, the exchange between participants with more and less experience of e-learning will be promoted. Aim of the group work is to call attention on general advantages and opportunities of e-learning for good land governance capacity building on one hand, but also to focus on



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difficulties and limitations of online learning tools on the other hand.

The group work will motivate participants to use and to develop e-learning tool by themselves and to benefit from experienced already made.

After the group work actual e-learning tools developed by TUM, GLTN and GIZ will be presented. Participants will know more about new open-access e-learning offers and future development targets of the three organizations.

Finally there will be a short brainstorming concerning which further topics could be suitable for e-learning for the participant and a platform for contact exchange for possible future cooperation will be provided.
